Then there are my personal experiences.

Stories about cars or events. Those articles tend to be the most fun. It’s my way of reliving the forty-five years or so I have been working in this crazy world we call Ferrari.

So, for the next couple pages I’m going to relive some of those stories, climb atop my soapbox and generally have some fun with this issue.

My first job with FAF Motorcars was towing broken Ferraris all around the southeast. I worked elsewhere and in the time between getting off work and the time I had to be back meant I could cover most nearby states.

The year was 1975 and my first trip was to Richmond, Virginia, to pick up a 365 GT from a parking

lot. I left work at four, drove to Richmond, arrived at midnight, loaded the car onto the trailer and was back in time to make it to work at nine.

Over the next couple years I did several trips just like that. It was good to be young.

It was the 1970s and I drove a Ford van. Yes, it had carpet on the walls and a bed built up in the back. It also had cabinets for storage and an icebox to keep drinks (beer) cold.

FAF had a trailer and a broken-down Chevy station wagon nobody trusted to go any farther than local drives. That's how I got involved. The trailer was open with a large wind, stone and bug deflector made of steel mounted on the front. It was orange which is why it became the "Orange Blossom Special".

With a CB radio in the dark of night, my buddy Mike, who worked for FAF, and I drove many a mile during those days of 55 mph speed limits. I would like to believe some of those turnaround times still have yet to be beaten. Smoky and the Bandit didn't have anything on us.

I know it is hard to believe cars were ever transported on an open trailer, but that's how it was at that time.

I picked up a 250 PF Coupe from a body shop in Mississippi. It was one of the few daytime trips I ever did. The car was apart and the body was perfect in primer. All the trim and upholstery was loaded into the van and we headed home.

About ten miles later I heard the jingle of chain and decided to stop to check the car. As I slowed down to about ten miles per hour to pull off the road suddenly the whole rig was pushed up to about thirty-five miles-per-hour! I got it all under control and moved onto the shoulder again to find the PF Coupe now nestled into the front of the trailer.

The chain we used to attach the rear axle to the trailer hung uselessly with all the hardware missing. Luck was with us that day as I walked back up the road to the point of sudden acceleration to retrieve the missing nut, bolt and washer. There was not a scratch on the car.

I had by that time towed several different Ferraris but none of them were as beautiful as that PF Coupe. If I had the money, I would have bought that car right then and there. FAF parted it out.

It now lives on as a GTO replica. When I saw the serial number, it was familiar so I looked it up. Sure enough, it was the one. There is a certain serendipity to being around Ferraris.

In 1977 I was finally hired in the parts department of FAF and really began to learn about Ferraris.

The FCA Annual Meet was at Road Atlanta in 1978. The host hotel was the PineIsle Resort and Golf Course. I had contracted with a gentleman in Miami to bring his Daytona Spyder up to the meet. He had planned on driving it back home after, so it was to be a one-way trip only.

I made arrangements for a U-Haul truck large enough to fit the Daytona inside. My other preparations were to gather the things I would need to tie the Ferrari down.

Eyebolts for the floor to strap the rear of the car down. A drill to put holes in the floor for the eyebolts. Wood blocks (2X4) to block the wheels, along with nails

and a hammer to mount them to the floor. And straps to hold the car.

I had a nearby gas station lined up with a drive-on lift. The plan was to back the car on the lift, back the truck up to the lift and drive it on. It was a good plan.

I caught a flight down to Miami with a duffle bag of tools and equipment. Now, security was not the same as today, but they still looked at the bags. I had a one-way ticket with a bag containing drill and bits, blocks of wood, nails and straps, and a hammer.

Security pulled me aside. I'm sure my story was suspect. They were not going to let this kid onto an airplane who claimed he was going to pick up a Ferrari and bring it back to Atlanta. Besides, I wasn't even wearing a suit or tie.

After much begging and explaining, security decided a drill with bits, nails, eye-bolts, etc., were OK to go on the airplane but the hammer had to stay. I dutifully dropped the hammer into a steel box that looked like it was made for dangerous weapons like hand grenades and other explosives.

The rest of the flight was uneventful. Loading the car was also uneventful. Even the drive from Miami was uneventful.

## **Eight hundred trouble-free miles in the back of a U-Haul truck...**

I had lined up a local garage to get the car off the U-Haul. Same procedure. Back up to the lift and back out. The Daytona would need to be driven a couple miles into the PineIsle complex. I found the customer and informed him of the plan.

Since the car was cleaned and detailed already, he didn't want to drive it the couple miles. He wanted to see the car and I opened up the door. A crowd gathered to see this beautiful spyder in the truck.

Sometimes, more help is not helpful. Ramps were produced and I reluctantly removed the straps and blocking. The customer insisted on driving his car off the truck and down the ramps.

With the ramps I wasn't sure the car could make the transition off the end of the truck. There was also no physical attachment of the ramps to the truck. All I could see is the Spyder falling off the end of the truck in front of a very large audience. I was no longer in control of anything.

The owner, while backing the car, panicked, and hit the brakes. One of the ramps slid off the truck and crashed to the ground. It was possible to place your hand on the bottom of the rear tire as it hung off the edge of the truck. Eight hundred trouble-free miles in the back of a U-Haul truck and I was getting ready to see this Daytona fall because of the enthusiasm of the crowd and two miles of asphalt.

A jack was produced and the back jacked high enough to slide the ramp back under the tire. With everybody holding their breath the owner was able to back down without any more drama.

The good news is there was not a scratch on the car, and it went on to win its class. Who knows? Maybe I started the specialized enclosed transport industry? Probably not, but it certainly was unique to see a car transported inside a truck. Different times for sure.

## A Season to Remember

A year ago in this space I recapped the 2020 Formula One season, yet another crushing triumph for Lewis Hamilton and the Mercedes AMG team. Since the hybrid formula was introduced in 2014, Mercedes and its drivers have held the world championship continuously, a stretch of 2,577 days.

In conclusion I asked: "Will 2021 feature an exciting new normal?"

Who could have guessed that 2021 would offer the most controversial and compelling championship in years, the first to go to the final race of the season since 2016, when Nico Rosberg edged teammate Hamilton. This season the two contenders came from different teams, and Hamilton was pushed to the limit by Max Verstappen of Red Bull Racing-Honda, who claimed his first World Championship with a daring pass on the final lap of the finale in Abu Dhabi.

A furor arose from the handling of that race finish by Race Director Michael Masi, whose decisions created a one-lap dash to the championship in which leader Hamilton was a sitting duck on worn tires against Verstappen's fresh rubber, especially after Masi removed the five lapped cars between the rivals. His was an excruciating dilemma: finish under caution, and Hamilton wins. Restart, with Verstappen's grip advantage and position on the leader's gearbox, and he likely triumphs. Initial appeals by Mercedes were denied at the track, but they have vowed to pursue the matter. For his part, Hamilton was gracious in defeat; he and his father Anthony even congratulated Max and father Jos in person.

The arguments come down to conflicting interpretations of the regulations. The rules may well be superseded, the stewards decided, by the Race Director's authority to run the race as he sees fit. Masi admitted his goal was a green-flag finish, and the result was incredibly exciting. A championship for either driver would have been entirely deserved, so the fans came up winners. Hopefully the issues will be ironed out in the off-season, and Mercedes will be satisfied with its eighth straight Constructors' championship.

Verstappen and Hamilton proved all season that they were performing on a totally different level than their competitors. Their battle see-sawed back and forth: Hamilton led the championship for the first four races. Then Verstappen won in Monaco to grab the points lead, holding it for six rounds. It changed hands four times in the next six races before Verstappen seized it for six more. That left only Abu Dhabi, where the two rivals arrived tied on points, something that had happened only once before in the 72 seasons of F1: 1974, when Emerson Fittipaldi and McLaren edged Clay Reggazoni's Ferrari at Watkins Glen.

Of course, the story of the 2021 season is about more than simple wins and losses, and the luck factor was always a presence. But for a tire failure while leading in Azerbaijan, two race-ending collisions with Hamilton at Silverstone and Monza, and being taken out at the first corner in Hungary, Verstappen might have clinched the championship with several races to spare.

Yet each time Hamilton fought back, topping a late-season charge with an astonishing weekend in Brazil in which he rushed from twentieth to fifth in the Saturday

"Sprint" race, and then repeated the feat, going from tenth on the grid to the win on Sunday. Also in that race Verstappen's aggressive defense against Hamilton sparked a disagreement over rules interpretation that would last the rest of the season.

There was also plenty of action among teams vying for "best of the rest" honors behind Mercedes and Red Bull. In addition to the points leaders, Sergio Pérez (Red Bull), Esteban Ocon (Alpine), Daniel Ricciardo (McLaren), and Valteri Bottas (Mercedes AMG) also won races. Another seven scored at least one podium finish, and points were scored by all but two drivers in the field: Haas-Ferrari teammates Mick Schumacher and Nikita Mazepin.

The biggest upward movers in the Constructors' championship were Scuderia Ferrari, who rebounded from sixth place last season to finish third, despite not winning a race for the second consecutive season. Between them Carlos Sainz and Charles Leclerc scored in 36 of their 44 races, and Leclerc added a pole in Monaco that he was unable to capitalize on due to mechanical issues.

Despite finishing fourth for the second season, McLaren also substantially improved on last year's financially-stressed campaign. Unlike consistent Ferrari, the orange cars endured an up-and-down season with a car that was fast on some circuits, and then an unsolvable puzzle on others. Daniel Ricciardo sailed to a much-needed victory at Monza, while Lando Norris was heartbroken to limp home seventh from pole in Russia after being caught out on old tires.

Another great battle waged for fifth among Constructors between Alpine-Renault and Alpha Tauri-Honda. The former Renault factory team got a maiden win for Esteban Ocon in Hungary with help from Fernando Alonso, who held a charging Hamilton at bay just long enough for his young teammate. Alonso also finished third in Qatar, a record 105 starts after his previous podium at Hungary in 2014.

The final season for Honda as an F1 engine supplier was also boosted by the Alpha Tauri team. Pierre Gasly was a consistent top-ten qualifier and points threat. Rookie Yuki Tsunoda struggled adjusting to the grand prix life, but scored in 7 races, including a season-best fourth in Abu Dhabi.

Aston Martin F1, it must be said, underperformed. After finishing fourth among constructors in 2020 as Racing Point, the operation tumbled to seventh this year despite the efforts of Sebastian Vettel and Lance Stroll. The scraps were collected by Williams-Mercedes, Alfa Romeo-Ferrari, and Haas-Ferrari. Actually, eighth in points was an improvement for Williams, in a season when the sport mourned the passing of team founder Sir Frank Williams.

As the calendar turns, there are inevitable changes to come, including a totally new car and a switch to 18-inch tires. Williams driver George Russell becomes Hamilton's new Mercedes teammate, replacing Valtteri Bottas, who moves to Alfa Romeo-Ferrari, while Chinese F2 star Guanyu Zhou bumps Antonio Giovinazzi from the other seat. Russell's Williams chair goes to ex-Red Bull driver Alex Albon. And we bid farewell to 2007 world champion Kimi Räikkönen. The sport's most experienced driver at 349 races, Ferrari's 2007 champion put the season in perspective with his usual flair; when asked about the new circuit in Saudi Arabia, he answered "It makes no difference to me. I'm not coming here next year."

But we are. Happy holidays, everyone!

## Driving Your Ferrari By Jim Weed

Enzo Ferrari thought it. Ed Gilbertson says it. Jim Weed advocates for it.

What is it?

Enzo Ferrari thought the horse pulls the cart. He also thought aerodynamics are for those who can't make horsepower. The music of every Ferrari is the sound the engine makes. Not at idle, but at maximum revolutions per minute.

Ed Gilbertson wrote the book for Ferrari concours standards. The IAC/PFA guidelines are designed to keep Ferraris in original condition. The idea is to allow owners to use and enjoy their cars while keeping the car in original condition. Points are deducted for incorrect items but not for normal wear and tear.

These guidelines were developed with the idea of keeping a Ferrari in good condition but not to be preserved in perfect unused condition. As Gilbertson's mantra extolls "Ferraris are meant to be driven!"

Which brings me to the Jim Weed advocacy. Ferraris should be driven. There is a part of me that doesn't understand why Ferraris aren't driven regularly. I come from a time when the cars were used more, enjoyed more and owners knew their ride better because of the experience.

### When you drive you should always be evaluating what the car is saying.

When I was service manager at FAF Motorcars, I got to drive every car that came into the shop. Often I drove them before we serviced them, and I absolutely drove each one after service. I drove many different cars at track events. Customers would want to know how their Ferrari drove and if it was really in tune or if there were problems they weren't aware of.

Test driving is an art. It requires having the ability to discern the smallest problem and determine if it required immediate attention or if it was something to watch for in the future. I could tell if tire pressure was low in one tire and which tire needed air when I got back.

The point is, when you drive you should always be evaluating what the car is saying. Cars do talk and while they can't speak in words they still can communicate with you. The only way to connect, mentally and physically, with your car is by having enough seat time to feel and hear what it is trying to say.

Is that noise normal, or has it changed from the last time? Does it feel the same around that corner? Has it changed? These are the subtle messages your car transmits. Are you listening?

The only way to learn is by spending time with your butt in the seat enjoying the ride. Jumping in every six months for a ride down the highway will not be enough.

The cars I worked on that were driven often always had the fewest problems. Fast cars like fast horses need to be exercised. A slow warmup to get the fluids mov-

ing with a close eye on temperatures is a good start. As the needles get close to normal it is time to up the revs. Four thousand and up to redline is where the magic happens. Enjoy the experience, forget the miles, the memories will be worth it.

I have a customer who has an F40. He really enjoys the car, drives it often and takes it to dinner, gravel parking lot be damned. To say he has fun with it would be an understatement.

He drives it often enough to be truly in tune with it. If it hiccups, he knows it. If it feels funny, he knows it. Would you be surprised if I told you he has a few miles on it? How about 32,000 miles and counting.

With that much seat time he knows that Ferrari and everything it can and can't do. He has a set route he enjoys with a favorite on-ramp, a transition and off-ramp. He can do speeds I won't relate here but you can bet they are speeds the car was made for. Not up to the edge, but 8/10s, maybe 9/10s without abuse.

But, but, what about the value? Look how much the value is hurt when its time to sell. Yes, that may be true, but how much will it be hurt? That is the great unknown.

What about the memories? Those are priceless. I see many cars advertised with low mileage and many go through the auctions with low mileage. Did those owners ever really get to enjoy the sounds and feel of their Ferrari?

There is no guarantee how much more your car will be worth if it is not driven. There is also no guarantee how much less it will be worth if you go out and have some fun. Life is full of "what ifs".

What if I took a trip with my Ferrari? Would that experience and memory last well after the car was gone? You bet it would. When you are sitting in the old-folks home reliving stories of your life, that trip will come off your hard drive over and over.

Rock chips can be fixed, bodywork can be repaired, and mechanical items can be replaced. It's like those scars you accumulated throughout your childhood and beyond that you wear as a badge of honor and courage. The dings in your Ferrari should be looked upon with pride.

Of course, I'm not advocating to not repair as necessary, but to enjoy and recognize how special it is to become 'at one' with your Ferrari.

Kevin Enderby owns an F355 GTS with over 160,000 miles. Think he knows exactly what his car can, and cannot do? It still wins awards at concours, not for the mileage, but for how perfect he keeps it. It has been totaled once and rebuilt, proving that damage can be repaired.

So, as we begin 2022 realistically look at your Ferrari and decide, are you a collector who wants to curate a museum or an enthusiast who wants to experience exactly what a Ferrari can do to stir your soul.

There is no wrong answer, we love all Ferraris, and each one has the perfect combination of beauty and power. We should be able to enjoy each in our own way.
